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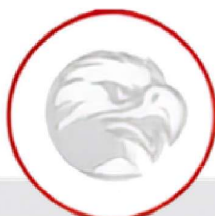
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WELCOME TO THE ST. JOHN'S FAMILY!

SNACKS AT SCHOOL

- Students do have designated times for snacks. **Please send healthy snacks that will sustain your child** between drop off and lunch and between lunch and dismissal. It's a good idea to have a snack ready in your car at the time of pick up to help your child successfully transition from a long day at school to the rest of your evening activities.
- Snack ideas: Crackers/Cheese, Summer Sausage/Crackers, String Cheese, Apple or Banana, Yogurt Cup, Pack of Craisins
- There is an emphasis on bringing healthy snacks and water to school. Please no cookies, juice, Gatorade, candy, etc.
- Students may bring a water bottle to refill.
- Parents may provide a plastic tub to store snacks in or can send a snack daily.

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NOTES FROM THE OFFICE

ATTENDANCE NOTES

- Please contact the office by email/phone to let us know about an absence/tardy
- All students who are leaving early/arriving late must sign in at the office
- Dr's notes are required for students who are absent due to illness 3+ consecutive days

BILLING & LUNCH MONEY NOTES

- All school-related fees (tuition, hot lunch, milk, field trips, athletics, etc.) will be billed through TADS.
- Payment can be made online through TADS or via cash or check (in a sealed envelope with your child's name and payment purpose). Mrs. Krueger will mark charges in TADS as paid.
- Please monitor your TADS account regularly. A \$50.00 late fee applies to past due payments.
- You can monitor your lunch funds through the Skyward system
- Add funds to your lunch account by emailing julie.marquardt@stjohnsmayville.com with the amount you would like added
- If you have financial concerns, please don't hesitate to reach out to Mrs. Krueger. We are here to help.

NO PERSONAL DEVICES DURING SCHOOL HOURS

- Cell phones, smart watches, Gizmo/Bark/Gabb watches, and any other personal devices are not permitted to be used during school hours. If phones, smart watches, Gizmo/Bark/Gabb watches are brought to school, they are required to stay in the classroom's designated area for personal devices.

CONTACTING OR VISITING YOUR CHILD DURING SCHOOL HOURS

- If parents or other family come to visit St. John's School, they must check into the office before visiting their intended location.

MORNING DROP OFF PROCEDURES

- To drop your student off curb side in the mornings, please come from the east of the school on Bridge Street. Pull up as far as you can in front of the school.
- Please have students exit your vehicle on the curb side.
- Do not park and leave your vehicle unattended at the drop off line location.

DEPARTURE PLANS & PROCEDURES

- There are multiple departure options at the end of the day:
 - Utilize the "pick up line" in the parking lot on Muzzy st. Details will be outlined at Open House.
 - With parent permission, students may walk to their destination.
 - Parents may park in the church parking lot or a side street and walk to pick up your student.
 - The Youth Center is open from 3:15-5pm for students 2nd grade and older to read, study, work on homework, or play a board game.

HOME GAMES

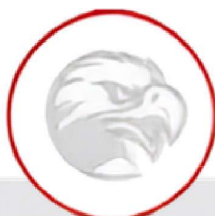
- Home games are a great way to get connected with our school and show school spirit! All St. John's families are welcome and encouraged to attend our home games!

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SCHOOL HELPFUL HINTS

PARENT INVOLVEMENT & ENGAGEMENT

- At St. John's School we pride ourselves in being family oriented and making families a priority! We do that by providing plenty of opportunities for parents to engage, be involved, volunteer, and participate!
- To help the success of the school, we recommend each family volunteers 10 hours a year
- Tuition scholarship recipients are REQUIRED to volunteer 10 hours a year.
- Families with students in sports are REQUIRED to volunteer 10 hours a year per student with a max of 20 hours or there will be a \$200 fee assessed at the end of the season for families that fail to meet their volunteer hours. These volunteer hours are different than tuition scholarship volunteer hours. These hours are mostly filled with coaching, concessions, running scoreboard, working a tournament, etc. These opportunities will be sent out by the Booster Club Coordinator.

 - Parents Day, Fundraisers, PTL and school events
- Watch for these parent volunteer opportunities:
 - Volunteer at a field trip, Attend a parent education class, Volunteer at the Youth Center, become a Connect Family, Kids Heart Challenge

CHAPEL FAMILIES

- Each student is put into a Chapel Family that includes 2 teachers that oversee the group and students from different grades.
- Throughout the year chapel families get together to do fun activities. This allows opportunities for mentorship, discipleship, and friendships to develop across grades and helps to unify our school as a whole.
- Within our Chapel Families are Chapel Partners. Each MS student is assigned 1 or 2 younger students to work with for the entire year. They will do activities together and older students will help the younger ones at whatever task is at hand.
- There are a couple times a year when Chapel Partners might give a gift to each other. This would be during the Christmas season and at the end of the year. This act of gift giving is not obligated but often happens organically.

TESTING

- Forward Testing will be held between April 5-April 16: For grades 3-8. Required once a year by the state to assess math, reading and SS/science.
- I Ready Testing: An internal diagnostic test we do three times a year for internal data monitoring. Only tests math and reading.
 - Fall Testing: September 8-September 18
 - Winter Testing: January 11-January 22
 - Spring Testing: May 3-May 14

STAFF APPRECIATION

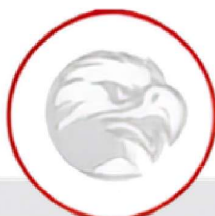
- Teacher Appreciation Week: Our PTL does something each day of the week for Teacher Appreciation Week. Some classes will organize a little something for their teacher. As an individual family, feel free but not obligated to recognize your child's teacher with a card or note as well!
- Christmas: In lieu of each student giving a gift to their teacher, many people will choose to give Scrip money towards a gift card of the staff member's choice. You will receive more details when it gets close to the holidays.

YEARBOOK SIGNING

- Students are not required to get a yearbook but as a whole school, we do take time out of the last week of school for people to sign year books. If a student does not have a yearbook for signing they will be given a notebook or piece of paper for others to sign.





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CHURCH TIPS

COMMUNION

- When students participate in church programs, you will want to be aware of St. John's communion practices. As stated by the church: WE PRACTICE CLOSE(D) COMMUNION ~ St. John's is a member of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod which practices Close(d) Communion. We strive to follow the Scriptural teachings of the Sacrament of the Altar as closely as possible. The practice of Close(d) Communion attempts to make sure that all those who come to this Altar publicly confess ALL that is believed and taught at this congregation
- Out of love for everyone partaking of the Sacrament, we attempt to put into practice the words of St. Paul in 1 Corinthians 11:27-30, "Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord... For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.
- St Paul also says in 1 Corinthians 11:26 "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes." Attending the Lord's Table is a public confession of what you believe. St. John's acknowledges the difference in beliefs and respects those of different denominations. If you are of a different confession or do not know our confession, we ask you to respect our practice of Close(d) Communion and please refrain from partaking at this time.

BAPTISM RECOGNITION

- Each month students who were baptised during that month are recognized at chapel.

CHRISTMAS PROGRAM

- Our Christmas programs include an "open" dress rehearsal where family is welcome to watch, and a performance on the Saturday after the rehearsal.

HOLY WEEK

- We celebrate National Lutheran Schools Week March 1st-5th, and our week is PACKED with lots of activities and fun!
- We kick off the Saturday prior with a PTL sponsored family dance or family night and on the Sunday prior we have our Lutheran Education Sunday service at 8 am that the whole school sings at.
- Monday of that week we enjoy a full day of festivities associated with Kids Heart Challenge. On the Wednesday/Thursday of that week we enjoy in an all-school chapel either onsite or offsite in collaboration with the Rock River Region Schools. On Friday we finish the week with Grandparents Day (a half-day; 11:30 am release). Grandparents Day is a day of sharing with our grandparents a glimpse into SJLS with chapel, engaging activities, projects, etc.
- Also sprinkled throughout the week we typically have dress up days.

CHAPEL BY GRADE

- During the school year, each class takes turns leading a Wednesday chapel service. The class will then perform that chapel service at Saturday's or Sunday's church service. Please make all efforts to attend the Saturday/Sunday service as all students have a role and is needed for the performance.
- Please note: parents are ALWAYS welcome to attend any of our chapel services throughout the year.

NOISEY CAN OFFERING

- Once a month, students can bring money for Chapel offering to put in our noisy can offering. The funds raised by our chapel offerings are donated to organizations with missions that we believe in and want to support!

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD PACKING PARTY

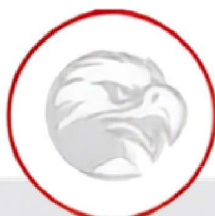
- This is a long standing tradition and a way for us to extend the gospel to those who we cannot personally reach!

CAMP TIMBERLEE

- Camp Timberlee is the camp that we attend throughout the school year!
- Outdoor Ed
 - We don't attend a "6th grade camp" but we do have Outdoor Ed in both 7th and 8th grades and our students LOVE it!
 - Mrs. Travis and Mrs. Parker lead the group each fall. They also have apx 4 parent chaperones attend to help.
 - This is a 2 night, 3 day camp (Monday - Wednesday) that is graded.
 - Fundraising for this camp starts in 6th grade
 - Outdoor Ed is an educational camp and Costs apx \$350 per student per year
- Winter Xtreme
 - This camp is an optional camp for 7th-8th grade students and is open to community youth as well.
 - There is no fundraising opportunities for this camp.
 - Held in January, Friday-Sunday
 - Winter Xtreme is a spiritual/Bible camp

ROOTED IN CHRIST YOUTH GROUP

- Rooted in Christ is St. John's Youth Group and is available to community youth in grades 5th-12th grades.
- On average, Rooted in Christ meets every other Sunday at the St. John's Youth Center.
- Rooted in Christ also participates in service projects throughout the year

WLA TRACK MEET

- All 5th-8th grade students participate in the WLA Track Meet in May
- Participation in preparation and in the track meet results in each student's 4th quarter gym grade
- The track meet is run as a real track meet and can result in students qualifying to attend the state track meet
- All practices and the track meet is held during the school day

5-8 PROJECT ROTATION

- The middle school has a 4 project (4 year) rotation so each student will do each project once
- 2026/27 World Fair, 2027/28 Interactive Dinner Theater, 2028/29 Frozen in Time, 2029/30 Children's Book
- These projects are a major portion of student's quarter 3 grades and are worked on in and out of school time
- At the end of the projects, parents, family & friends will have the opportunity to see the final results of the project

PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

- Student Teacher Conferences are held each quarter
- For MS, parents will sign up for a 30 minute time slot. MS teachers will be spread out throughout the gym. Parents will make their way to each teacher they would like to meet with as teachers are available.
- Student Led Conferences
 - For the 4th quarter, MS students will prepare and lead their own parent teacher conference. Students will work with their homeroom teachers to reflect on their school performance and prepare and present the information to their parents with their teacher present to help.

LATE PASSES

- Students get 2 late passes per class per quarter to use on late assignments.
- If a student has a late assignment, they may turn it in for full credit if they have a late pass for the class available.
- Student do get rewarded if they have not used any late passes by the end of the quarter

LOCKERS

- MS students are assigned a locker that is used regularly every day
- Traditional wooden lockershelves function better than plastic or fabric lockershelves
- The measurements for locker shelves are: Depth - 14 in, Width - 11.5 in, Height - 60 in

MERRY BASKETS

- It is a tradition for the MS classes to work together to put together Merry Baskets to be hand delivered by the 7th and 8th grade classes to members of the St. John's Church Congregation.
- Class participation includes donating ingredients/ snacks, making chex mix, putting baskets together, and delivering baskets
- Christmas Carols are also sung when baskets are delivered

STUDENT COUNCIL

- MS students have the opportunity to practice leadership and volunteerism by participating in Student Council.
- Student Council meets once a month before school and hosts multiple events throughout the school year
- Students have the opportunity to run for an officer position in Student Council. Those running for a position do run a campaign by hanging posters throughout the MS.

AWARDS & AWARDS NIGHT

- Each month student's have the opportunity to earn awards that are nominated and selected by MS staff
 - Academic Leadership
 - Strives for excellence
 - Takes pride in doing neat, careful work
 - Has great classroom participation
 - Comes prepared for class
 - Has used minimal late passes
 - Has minimal tardies
 - Might have shown academic improvement
 - Christian Leadership
 - Demonstrates a positive attitude
 - Shows a God-pleasing treatment of others
 - Is a good role model
 - Is honest
 - Is responsible
 - Has an admirable worship life
 - Embodies Friendly catchphrase for the month
- Each quarter students have the opportunity to earn different awards
 - Honor Roll (90%-92% with no grades lower than 'C')
 - High Honor Roll (93%-95% with no grades lower than 'C')
 - Principals List (96%-100% with no grades lower than 'C')
 - Exemplary Church Attendance (Attended at least 90% of all regular weekend church services)
 - Bug Award (Brought Up Grades) Awards will be given to students who have significantly brought up: (1) 7% increase in core subject without a decrease of 7% or more in any other core subject area and/or (2.) 3% increase overall GPA. (3.) No failing/unsatisfactory grades in any core or noncore subjects.)
- At the end of the school year the MS hosts an awards night where each student is recognized for their accomplishments
 - Parents and family are invited to attend but require an RSVP
 - It is highly recommended for each student to come, if possible, as every student will be recognized

OPPORTUNITIES FOR EXCELLENCE

- MS students are given many opportunities for excellence beyond every day academics and Christian leadership.
 - LEAD - Students are selected by MS staff
 - Spelling Bee - Students are determined by spelling performance in school
 - Knowledge Bowl - Students are determined by trivia performance in school
 - Scrapbooking Club - Students can volunteer to be a part of this club
 - Student Council - Students can volunteer to be a part of this club

8TH GRADE TRIP

- 8th grade students go on a 4 day trip down south at the end of April
- Fundraising starts in 6th grade
- Trip typically includes the Louisville Slugger Museum, The Ark Museum, The Creation Museum, an aquarium, and more!
- \$877 per student - not to exceed 30% of SJLS tuition
- Paid in 3 payments throughout 1 year
- There will be a meeting with preparations and all the details

8TH GRADE GRADUATION & 7TH GRADER'S ROLE

- 8th grade graduation is held in the church and is followed by snacks and a presentation by the 7th graders in the fellowship hall
